Dear Parents,

As you may or may not be aware the school's swimming pool is funded solely through SISA's fund-raising events held at various times during the school year.

Each year SISA has covered all additional maintenance / running costs that were not covered by the voluntary contributions collected. These additional costs amount to approximately £3000 to £3500 per year.

In order that we may continue to provide the very best for your children we need to request the usual voluntary contribution to general operating and running costs of the pool, which **includes** the cost of pupils swimming lessons.

This year, the half term's lesson cost is inclusive of an end of term achievement certificate for each child.

**The costs are: £35.00 for one child
 £50 for two or more children**
