

What the Parent Support Advisor aims to achieve when working with you:

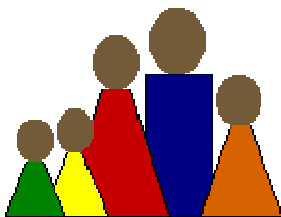
- Building your confidence in dealing with difficult parenting issues and behaviour


