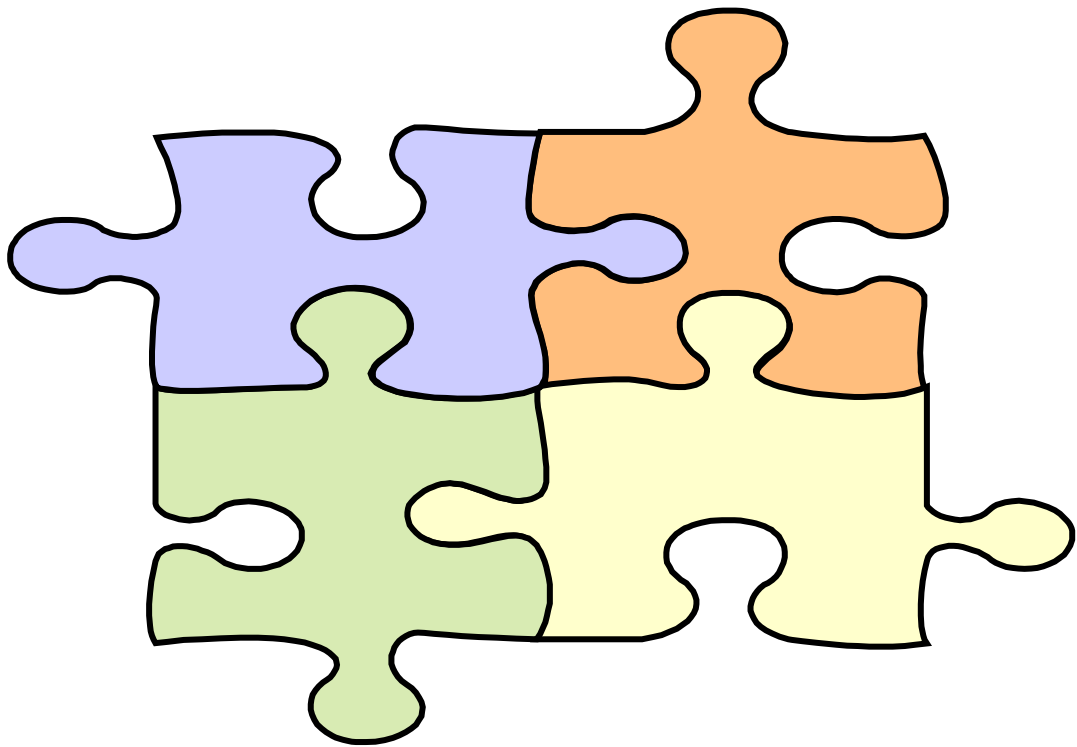

Please make sure your child is reading at least four times week at home. Please remember to sign reading records, as your child could miss out on winning a prize!! Thank you.

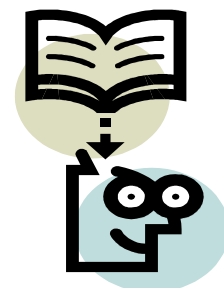
## Website
